### MO: Medical Only Adjuster

MO – Medical Only Adjuster requires 80 hours with 50 in a classroom covering all topics except TTD, PD, Death benefits, RTW/VR; S&W Misconduct, and Apportionment). Required statutory topic courses include:

#### Required Modules
